

Presbyterian Women Circles

HOMEBUILDERS CIRCLE

An intergenerational Circle of women that meet each month on the 2nd Wednesday at 9:30am at the church. Initially a Circle of stay-at-home moms, it is now a homogenous blend representing everything a modern woman can be. The Circle studies specially selected Bible lessons. A nursery can be provided, if needed.

LINDA WELLER CIRCLE

This Circle meets the 1st Monday of each month at 7:00pm in the homes of members or at the church. The Horizons Bible study is used. In addition, this circle focuses on both big and small projects during the year.

MORNING GLORIES CIRCLE

This Circle meets the 1st Tuesday of each month at 11:00am in church Class Room A. Meetings are open to anyone who would like to fellowship with us, study God's Word and join in our projects. The Horizons Bible Study is used.

NIGHTINGALES CIRCLE

This Circle meets the 1st Tuesday of each month at 6:30pm at the homes of members. We work on various projects for our community and church throughout the year. We use the Horizons Bible Study.

GOOD FRUIT

The Good Fruit Circle meets the 2nd Tuesday of each month at 11:00am in members' homes to spiritually support and nurture women, as we grow in our awareness of the power of Christ in all of our life experiences. The Horizon Bible Study is used.

Presbyterian Women meet as a group 3 times a year at the Gatherings. These celebrations of fellowship are highlighted by the worldwide missions of the Thank Offering, Birthday Offering and the Least Coin.

These events are our way of giving back to women the world over with our gifts to relieve pain, provide clean water, alleviate homelessness, provide educational opportunities, promote health and improve the lives of women and children.

The Thank Offering was established in 1888.

The Birthday Offering was established in 1922 and the Fellowship of the Least Coin in 1958.

The PW, as a group and through the individual Circles, take on projects throughout the year to help those in need, both locally and internationally.

All women are welcome and encouraged to attend the Gatherings to see what your fellow sisters are doing for God and the Church. We would also invite you to join a Circle to deepen your relationship with Jesus Christ and your sisters in Christ.
