People: Nevertheless, as we mature in love and faithfulness in our life with Christ, we live in freedom and good cheer, bearing witness on good days and evil days, confident that the new life is pleasing to God and helpful to others.

Leader: The new life finds its direction in the life of Jesus, his deeds and words, his struggles against temptation, his compassion, his anger, and his willingness to suffer death.

People: The teaching of apostles and prophets guides people in living this life, and the Christian community nurtures and equips them for their ministries. We confess our faith when we bear a present witness to God's grace in Jesus Christ. Amen.
