COVID Policies and Procedures

Effective 5/9/2021

FPC has adopted the following wellness and cleaning protocols for our nursery. These procedures are aligned with current (as of April 2021) CDC and Georgia Department of Public Health guidelines for childcare programs.

1. The childcare worker will conduct a brief health screening before children can be dropped off. Children will have their temperature taken with a contactless thermometer.
2. *Parents are encouraged to limit the number of personal items for children.* All personal items (diapers, blankets, bottles, cups, etc.) must be labeled with your child's name. These items will be stored in a cubby and kept out of reach of children.
3. *Snacks will be limited.* All snack items will be individually packaged.
4. Children will wash their hands (or use hand sanitizer) at the following times: *arrival, before eating, after restroom, and prior to departure.*
5. Parents/other visitors will not be allowed inside the nursery area.
6. *All childcare workers must wear masks, but masks are not required for children under 4 years of age.*
7. Childcare workers will encourage social distancing.
8. *Toys will be cleaned and nursery area will be sanitized after services each Sunday.* Any toy that is placed in a child's mouth will immediately be set aside for cleaning.
9. The nursery will remain closed except for services on Sundays.
